The Out of the Cold program offers overnight accommodation to 30 men along with an evening meal, breakfast and brown bag lunch. While at St. Margaret's the men may take showers and do their laundry. This program is available every Monday night/Tuesday morning.

The Monthly community dinner provides a meal on the third Friday of every month (just before the social assistance cheques are received in the community) to 120-150 clients.

Christmas dinner is provided on December 25 to 300 guests every year – including an increasing number of families with small children. This event includes a Christmas gift.

Other programs include A Food Cupboard that provides emergency food; a seniors' program; AA meetings, conducted twice a week; and Social programs such as pancake supper, strawberry and peach festivals
