### Special Presentation

**Don MacInnes** introduced **David Windeyer**, retired National Director, Charitable Trust Services of the Bank of Nova Scotia Trust Company.

David spoke about the role of an "Estate Trustee", a designation formerly known as an "Executor". He emphasized how important it is to distribute the accumulations of an individual's lifetime. He drew attention to some of the resources available to help with the process such as legal services, accounting advice, investment specialists, corporate executor and insurance specialist.

Some of the functions of the Estate Trustee include:

- Examine & understand the will
- Make funeral arrangements
- Overview the assets and beneficiaries
- Communicate often with beneficiaries
- Set up an accounting system
- Collect asset information
- Value and protect estate assets
- Apply for and obtain probate
- Assemble assets and liquidate
- Settle liabilities
- Begin distribution after above is complete

David stressed the value of leaving donations to the Kiwanis Club of Kingsway Humber Foundation because 100% of the amount is tax exempt in the year of the donor's death. **Barnaby Ross** re-emphasized the importance of having an Estate Trustee and of preparing all documents.

**Frank Sgarletta** thanked David for a very informative presentation.
