**Bo Fleischman** gave a report on the **Real Estate** industry. He described the current market as "the best of times and the worst of times", with high prices and a high rate of personal debt.

Toronto has shown a steady rise in house prices - 9% in 2010 and 8% in 2011. The average house price today is \$575,000. Real Estate, as a nest egg, is a tax free investment at the time of sale. Condos in Toronto are overbuilt and Bo sees a calming in that market, as well, a dip may be coming.
