# Special Presentation & Interclub

Barnaby Ross introduced Manuel Parreira, Senior Regional Representative of the Bank of Canada, who spoke to us on how the Bank of Canada will be combating counterfeit bills via polymer bank notes (plastic money).

The new polymer notes were first circulated in November with a \$100 note. A \$50 note will be added this month. The other denominations are to follow in 2012 and 2013.

Mr. Parreira captured the interest of the group when he demonstrated the cutting edge security features of the new bills. He informed the group that most people only check the colour of the notes and do not know what to do to ensure the notes are real.

He demonstrated to us the following three steps in ensuring a note is real:

Feel- the smooth, unique texture of the note. Look- through the transparent outline and check for a frosted maple leaf window. Flip - the note to see these images from the front repeated in the same colours and detail on the back.

Mr. Parreira circulated both counterfeit and new \$50 notes so that we could see and feel the difference.
