Alberta Craft led us in a moving Remembrance service to honour those who have served, and continue to serve our country during times of war, conflict and peace.

Don MacInnes presented an overview of the Kiwanis Club of Kingsway Humber Foundation.

In 1970 a bequest of \$150,000 was received for relief of poverty, advancing education, community and religion. A foundation was established as a separate entity from the club and an investment account was established. A minimum of 90% of the earnings must be spent each year.

Currently the fund's value is \$374,000 (\$285,00 book value) and the return is 4.67%. There are no management fees on the account. Don suggested that people consider making a contribution to the Foundation through provisions in your will.
