Rich thanked Kiwanis for 25 years of support, supporting 300 or more children with a total of \$10,000 in donations. There are six leagues in Etobicoke for boys ages 13 - 19. In the early 70's there were 800 players on 60 teams. Today there are 500 players on 40 teams. At the same time as the recreational teams are dwindling the the competitive teams are growing.

The cost of ice time has increased 500%! The league has been working on ways to attract players by reducing the \$500 cost of registration. Some initiatives include a loyalty program, bursaries, discounts for bringing a friend and for additional family members.

Carol thanked us for 20 years of support - since the league's inception. There are 900 players on 24 house league teams and 19 competitive teams - the third largest league in the OWHA.

The Master Card Centre in South Etobicoke is their new home. Ice time at the Centre is \$350 per hour. The City rinks charge \$165 per hour. They have raised \$10,000 for breast cancer awareness through the "Pink the Rink" tournament.

The league is a "second home" for the girls where everyone has a role and has a chance to reach their potential as a player and as a person.
