Dwight Throop introduced **Major Andrew McCorquodale**, who is an Air Combat Systems Officer with the Canadian Air Force.

Andrew joined the military in 1993 and the events of 911 changed his military career. His work as a Junior Flight Navigator in Afghanistan was a high pressure, intense training experience. As project manager of the Heron, unmanned aircraft, he was involved in surveillance and security operations in Kabul and combat operations in Kandahar.

The situation in Afghanistan is challenging. Military force is not enough to solve the problems. A viable alternative is required, where the Canadian Forces could be one part of the entire approach, for example mentoring to the Afghan Army.

In 2011 the departure from Afghanistan will begin. Operations there have defined careers and strengthened our sense of pride and accomplishment. It was an opportunity to help those who were unable to provide it for themselves.
