Bruce Sinclair introduced **Susan Larkin**, National Director of Community Engagement for UNICEF Canada.

UNICEF was able to deliver \$165,000 of relief money to Haiti on time for the matching government funding. Since UNICEF has been in Haiti for 60 years they were there to deal with the disaster. Even though their offices were destroyed in the earthquake, they led the efforts in water and sanitation, as well as child nutrition and protection. They are part of a management team to transform Haiti into a better place than before the quake.

The HIV/AIDS project in the Caribbean is raising one million dollars over three years. Worldwide there are 33 million people with HIV/AIDS (as many as the entire population of Canada). The Caribbean has the second highest prevalence and we have the chance to eradicate it there. Half of the million dollar pledge has been raised. The Kiwanis outreach program is uniting for children and AIDS prevention.
