May 7, 2018

Heather Fullerton is the Director of Development for **Haven on the Queensway**. The building, originally a strip club was purchased by a private citizen who then sold it for a low cost to enable it to become a community centre. The same person provided all the funding to renovate the building for the community.

Heather thanked our club for the \$3,000 donation that was matched by the Weston Family Foundation. Most of our funding went to the Formula, Diapers and Smiles program to support new mothers who seek assistance from Haven. This program supports many young mothers, including refugee families who are struggling just to feed their babies. Also a portion of our funding went to provide milk so that each child would receive a litre of milk each week from Haven as part of their food distribution every Wednesday. Heather provided some individual stories of the needs of people and families that ask for help from Haven and how Haven provides food, clothing, small household items, baby items along with small furniture/high chairs/strollers, filled backpacks and new children's books. Heather also included information on the other programs that Haven provides including trips, workshops and gatherings for isolated seniors and a bus that visits twice a week with food, water, clothing and support for the homeless living in the streets of Etobicoke.
